A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
DIRECTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE AND RESCUE SQUAD RELIEF ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this township recognizes the great sacrifice made by volunteer members of the community to provide volunteer ambulance and rescue service to the residents of Washington Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors further recognizes that the creation of a relief association is appropriate not only to provide financial assistance to such community volunteers, but also in order to encourage other persons of the community to become involved in the mercy service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes that the creation of a relief association to administer funds is necessary for proper community support of such volunteers and their families and beneficiaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that they will recognize a relief association to be known as the Washington Township Volunteer Ambulance and Rescue Squad Relief Association, Inc., or such other similar name as may be made available by the Corporation Bureau of the Department of State and the Board further directs the solicitor to do any and all acts necessary for the creation of the aforesaid relief association.
