THIS RESOLUTION

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, authorizing volunteer firemen of the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company to engage in certain activities to be covered by Workmen's Compensation Insurance.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township expend out of the general Township Fund monies necessary to secure Workmen's Compensation Insurance for volunteer firemen to the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company killed or injured while going to, returning from, or attending fires in said township or territory adjacent thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 713 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. Sec. 65713, as amended, empowers the Township to provide such Workmen's Compensation Insurance for such volunteer firemen while performing such other duties as authorized by the said Township; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township to expand the activities of said volunteer firemen coverable by said Workmen's Compensation Insurance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, authorizes the volunteer firemen of the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company to engage in such fund raising activities as the officers of the said Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company deem necessary for the efficient operation of the Company, as well as to engage in and participate in firemen's training schools, firemen's conventions and such meetings and civic functions of the type customarily attended by and participated in by volunteer fire company members.

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Workmen's Compensation Insurance shall be provided for such volunteer firemen of the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company as shall be killed or injured while going to, returning from, or attending such activities as enumerated above.
