RESOLUTION NO. 341

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AT TOWNSHIP MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this Township deems it to be in the public interest to establish guidelines for the public comment period of public meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Board with these guidelines would like to provide an opportunity for all individuals to express their opinions within the time allotted for public comments; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes these guidelines are necessary in order to provide that the public comment portion of the meetings shall be held in an orderly manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the board of Supervisors of this Township as follows:

- 1. Prior to speaking, the person desiring to speak must state his/her full name and address.
- 2. The person speaking shall be allowed three minutes to make his/her comments.
- 3. The public comment period shall be for a maximum of one (1) hour.
- 4. All persons speaking shall be allowed to address the Board only one time.
- 5. If an individual does not have an opportunity to address the Board or he/she is unable to complete his/her comments within the three-minute time period, he/she shall be allowed to make a written statement to the Board.
